1	The Rendez-vous 2017 Tall Ships Regatta is organised by Tall Ships International Limited (TSIL), a Sail Training International company.
2	The Guest Ports Programme is categorised in accordance with the current edition of Sail Training International Racing & Sailing Rules & Special Regulations. The organisers reserve the right to refuse acceptance of an entry. The minimum water line length for all vessels is 9.14m (30ft). VHF radio and a type approved 406MHz EPIRB is compulsory.
3	For the Rendez-vous 2017 Tall Ships Regatta, whilst no upper age limit is imposed, all ships entering the Regatta are encouraged to recruit trainees between the ages of 15 and 25. No person under the age of 15 is to be on board during the Regatta unless approved by Sail Training International. For further details see Sail Training International Racing & Sailing Rules & Special Regulations, Part 3, Sections A and B.
